

Preschool Fees

We accept children from 2 years of age. Many children will qualify for funded hours.

Funded childcare (30 hours) for working parents starts from 9 months old and can be used the term after the child is 9 months.

If you do not meet the criteria and are claiming certain benefits, you may be entitled to 15 hours funding from the term after your child turns 2.

All children are automatically entitled to 15 hours funding the term after they turn 3.

Parents are directed to www.beststartinlife.gov.uk to apply online for 9 months - 4 years old working-parents funding, or check whether they may be entitled to 2 year old funding

If you do not qualify for funding, or you want your child to attend for additional hours, the cost will be £6.00/hour.

This will be invoiced in advance at the end of the previous month and we ask parents/carers to make a bank transfer into our account. Payment is due on/by 1st of the month. If your payment is late we reserve the right to charge you 10% for every full week that payment is not received and could suspend care for your child. No additional sessions can be booked until payment is received.

Fees are payable even if your child does not attend for the session/extended session.

We ask for a voluntary contribution from all families (funded and private) of £2/per/child/per day to support us to provide everything above and beyond that covered by government funding so we are able to provide a high standard of care, learning and fun for your child during their time at preschool.
